

You and all independent contractors, agents and sub-agents used by you to make solicitation calls pursuant to your business relationship with Priority One Clearing Services, Inc., must comply in all respects with the Telephone Consumer Protection Act of 1991 (“TCPA”), the Telemarketing Consumer Fraud and Abuse Preventions Act of 1994 (“TCFA Act”), the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) rules and regulations implementing the TCPA, the Federal Trade Commission (“FTC”) rules and regulations implementing the TCFA Act, and all relevant State laws, rules and regulations concerning telephone solicitation activities.

Compliance with the foregoing laws, rules and regulations includes, but is not limited to, the requirement that you and all independent contractors, agents and sub agents used by you to make solicitation calls for Priority One Clearing Services, Inc. in accordance with the laws, rules and regulations regarding the following:

- Ensuring that all telephone calls soliciting and subscriptions to the Magazines made by you and all independent contractors, agents and sub agents used by you are made from calling lists that have been scrubbed against your Do Not Call (“DNC”) List for the appropriate Magazine, the National DNC List, and any applicable State DNC List, and that absent an appropriate exception, no calls are made to numbers on any such DNC list.
- Calling time restrictions.
- Disclosure of information and identification requirements.
- Record keeping requirements.
- Requirement of establishing and maintaining a DNC Policy and a DNC List for each Magazine, and training and informing all employees, independent contractors, agents and sub agents used by you in the appropriate use of the DNC Policy and DNC Lists.
- Obtaining appropriate access to the National DNC List and appropriately utilizing such access.
- Obtaining appropriate access to any applicable State DNC List and appropriately utilizing such access.
- Abandoned calls, including the record keeping requirements.
- The transmission of Called-Id.
- The need for express verifiable consent for specified payment methods and for specified offers that you may be authorized to make.
- The use of a predictive dialer or automatic telephone dialing system to make solicitation calls to cell phones.
- Obtaining access to a database of phone numbers ported from wireline to wireless service to avoid predictive dialer, automatic dialing system and artificial or pre recorded voice calls from being made to such numbers within the time provided by applicable rules.
- The use of prerecorded or artificial voice message calls.
